Building Material Boom - 2021

John Burns, CEO of John Burns Real Estate Company, predicts \$400 billion dollars could be spent in 2021 and 25% of next year's growth will be spent on single family home construction. Part of Burn's overall spending forecast includes a surge in building materials spending due to the number of homes that were built in the early 2000's, soon approaching the age of 15 to 20 years old, and are due for remodeling projects. About 46.4 million homes were due for remodel in 2015 with about 48.6 million due in 2020. Looking ahead to 2022, more that 51 million homes will require updates and upgrades. "All that (building) boom from 20 years ago should result in strong repair and remodeling."

The pandemic has caused delays to the cycle of new construction and Burns believes this will result in a "big-time boom" in 2021. With family's staying in their homes longer, they are upgrading their homes and building material dealers are reporting shortages of materials. These materials include, decking, lumber, roofing products, lawn, and garden to name a few. Rest assured, Parliment is not experiencing such shortages, however, we have experienced some delays in shipments coming from our overseas suppliers. Overall, Burns said repair and remodeling spending should grow by about 6% in 2021. Custom home builder orders are strong, Burns states." As multifamily construction declines. Burns notes that his firm was already forecasting a multifamily decline due to previous over building in the past decades. "Permanent unemployment peaked at 10.5% during the Great Recession with that figure standing at 6.1% now. Job losses have been concentrated in lower-income brackets, which have the least impact on the home builders, burns noted." In the meantime, money is flowing into single-family rental construction. American Homes For Rent is building at least 1500 homes per year and is now the 40th largest home builder in the country. Burns said that the home rental market is "no longer an existing-home game, it's a new home game."

From the PBP perspective we look for a robust 4th quarter and a great 2021 for residential construction.
