#### **Annual Prediction Time -**

This issue marks our 16<sup>th</sup> year of doing the Parliment Pages. Time flies when you are having fun. Checking in on 2019 housing starts, we found the single-family housing starts were around 900,000. We predicted 910,000 to 925,000. On the multi-family front, the starts were around 380,000, we predicted 360,000 to 370,000. We think 2020 will see a modest 2%-3% increase over 2019. Not great, but surely not bad.

#### **Great Leadership**

The tariff war continues to be a factor in our business. The threat of increase from 25% to 30% on October 15<sup>th</sup> was averted, however, the 25% tariff is still in effect. Sources say we are close to making a deal with China. Hopefully this happens in the first quarter of 2020. We will keep you updated as the year moves on.

### **Housing Update**

A recent Wells Fargo article asked the question "Is homebuilding finally awakening from its decade long summer?" The answer is sort of. With mortgage rates below 4% and the fed looking like it is on hold for the foreseeable future, housing finally has the wind at its back. A factor restraining home buying is the declining movement between regions of the country this past decade. Recent data from the Census Bureau show migration within the United States has fallen to its slowest pace in the past 50 years. Over the past decade, a large proportion of those moving within the United States appear to be clustering in the tech drive markets in the west and south. Only 20 of the 50 largest metropolitan areas have seen significant net migration since 2010. The metro areas of Texas, Florida, and North Carolina tend to dominate this list. The leading edge of the millennial generation will turn 39 in 2020, and a rising number will reach their late thirties every year into the middle of the next decade. These improving demographics coincide with improving affordability, which stems from lower mortgage rates and stronger income growth. With all this good news we are expecting a good 2020 and a great 2021.
