Tariff Update

Well, March has come and gone and still no resolution with China on tariffs. As you may recall last year there was a 10% tariff on most Chinese products we buy. The threat still exists for an additional 15% at an undetermined date. There is also a threat of anti-dumping or countervailing duty suits on China. If either of those things occur it will be much worse than tariffs. The US and Chinese delegations are meeting as we are writing this newsletter to resolve the conflict. We will keep you in the loop as things progress.

Tariff Side Note

When the tariff is paid by the importer of record, it is paid directly to the United States Treasury. There have been billions of dollars paid so far. One thing we have learned over the years is that any revenue stream to our treasury is grandfathered in for life. So, we do not see the 10% tariff ever being rescinded and the possibility of higher tariffs in the future still exists.

Political Thoughts

The Mueller report has been completed and sent to the U.S. Attorney General. He will decide what will be finally released to "We the People". No matter how this plays out someone will not be happy. With that said, it seems Trump came out on top. No collusion on his part or any family member after a two-year investigation. There is still a great amount of animosity between the political parties. A congressman friend told us the partisanship is twice as bad as the media portrays.

On a brighter note, there appears to be a consensus on a national infrastructure bill. There is still a lot to iron out. However, we think something will be passed this year that the Congress and the President can agree upon.

<u>Housing</u>

New home sales appear to be growing. According to a Wells Fargo report, there was a 1% sales drop in February, following a 4.3% increase in January. March existing home sales rebounded with an 11.2% increase, the sharpest rate since December 2015. Housing starts in January jumped 18.6% after a 14% increase in December. 30 Year fixed mortgage interest are 4.28% as compared to 4.45% a year ago. 15-year fixed mortgage interest stands at 3.71%, a year ago it was at 3.91%. If the Federal Reserve continues its trend, we believe there will be no increase later this year. We also predict interest rate decreases in 2020 of up to .5%. Do not forget 2020 is an election year.

<u>Markets</u>

The merger of Gerdau and CMC has been completed. It was the smoothest merger and acquisition we have ever been involved in. With that said we are down to two major rebar manufacturers in the U.S. On the merger/acquisition front there is still a lot of activity. Just to name a few, Boise bought American Lumber Distributors and Brokers, a two-step distributor in Alabama, and Cameron Ashley just inked a deal with Warrior Building Products in St. Louis, MO.
